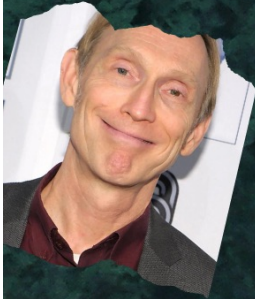

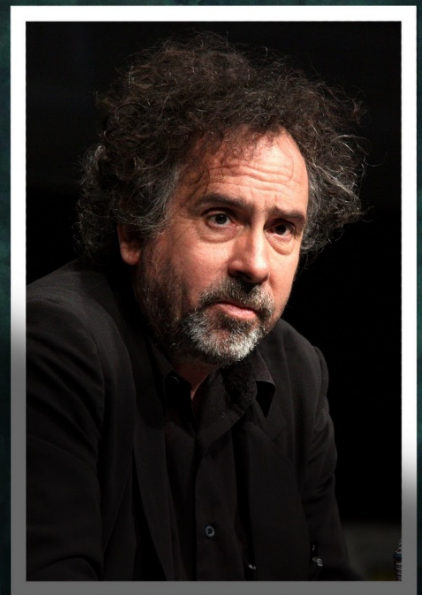


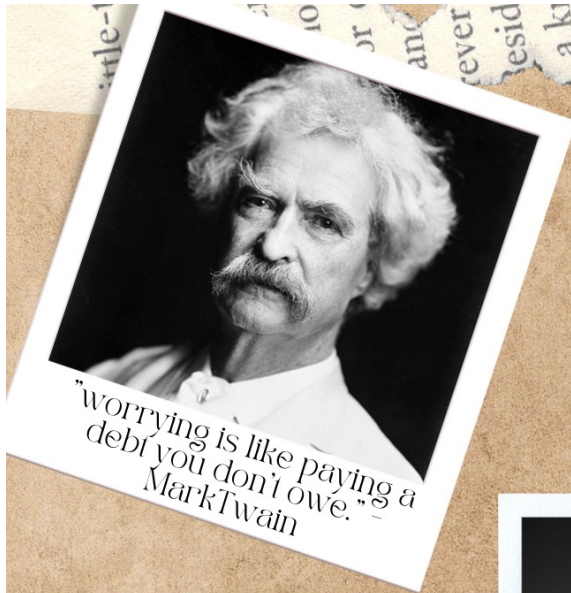

I feel their dark styles bring them together and they can bins over their odd and creepy personality's.



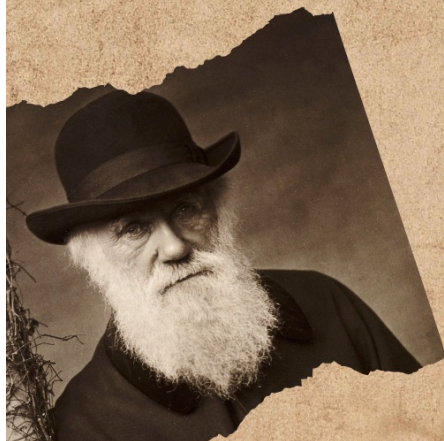
